I once was lost but now am found, was blind but now I see

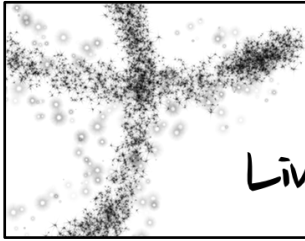
Through many dangers, toils, and snares I have already come
