3. How might **you** define 'faith'?
4. Is faith important to you? What does it mean to you?
5. How important is it to have faith in the right person or object? Does it matter or is it good enough to just have faith?
6. Nicky referenced Rom. 10:17, "Faith comes from hearing ... through the word" If that's true and if faith is an important concept, what do you suppose the 'word' might enlighten us on? What should we hope or expect to find in the 'word'?
7. What do you think about the evidence for Christianity that was presented here? How certain can we be over the existence of 'sin'? How certain can we be that we are sinners - people who bring about sin? Is love a plausible remedy to our sin? If yes, how do you suppose we might comprehend this love?

8. Do you remember the William Holman Hunt painting? What was significant about that painting? Could you recognize an attribute of love in the painting? Where was the door handle? Any significance to the placement of the handle?
9. How do you see the relationship between faith and religion? Do you think it is necessary to be religious in order to have faith? (Jas. 1:27)
10. Can a person have faith in someone that he/she can't see? How? (John 16:8 – Rom. 8:15-16 – 2 Cor. 5:17)
