- **Requirements:** Professional Educators License (PEL) required. LBS1 (Learning Behavior Specialist) or equivalent Special Education endorsement preferred.

Responsibilities

- Interpret student assessment data for application of instructional methods and monitoring of student progress.
- Review student progress via assessments, maintain records of student work, and develop intervention strategies to ensure student success and growth.
- Communicate both verbally and in writing with parents and students on progress.
- Set clear expectations for classes, manage classroom and school environment applying positive behavior supports and interventions as needed.
- Act as a role model by encouraging appropriate behaviors that lead to spiritual, social, emotional, and physical development.
- Engage in co-teaching partnerships across general education classrooms.
- Utilize dedicated preparation time to collaborate and meet regularly with instructional staff.
- Meet regularly with general education teachers, support teachers, teacher assistants, and specialists to discuss individual student's modifications or adaptations, ongoing learning issues, interventions, or problems.
- Develop and implement individualized service and accommodation plans to support students' academic success.
- Coordinate and facilitate meetings to ensure individualized services and accommodations align with students' academic goals and needs.
